Rules and Eligibility Requirements for Applicants

1. The Panagiotis K. Proimos Memorial Scholarship is designed to serve from the widest possible range of the following Greek Orthodox churches:
 - SS. Constantine and Helen, Merrillville, IN
 - St. Demetrios, Hammond, IN
 - St. George, Schererville, IN
 - St. Iakovos, Valparaiso, IN
 - St. Andrew, South Bend, IN
 - Assumption, Chicago, IL (Hegewisch)
2. Applicants and/or their parents/guardians be current members in good standing at one of the above stated churches and will need to enclose a letter in good standing from their respected church.
3. Applicants must be in their senior year of high school or its equivalent.
4. The scholarships are not renewable.
5. Applicants must present proof of registration or acceptance with their application.
6. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation with their application.
7. Applicants must submit a high school transcript with their application.
8. **All applications must be submitted by May 10, 2021.** Only completed applications will be considered (this includes the essay, letter in good standing, two letters of recommendation, high school transcript, and proof of acceptance or registrations).
9. The scholarships will be awarded on Graduate Sunday, June 6, 2021 at SS. Constantine and Helen (8000 Madison Street, Merrillville, IN).
Applicants must be present on the day of presentation unless there is an unforeseen reason they cannot attend Graduate Sunday.
